## Shirakawa is full of such excitement.

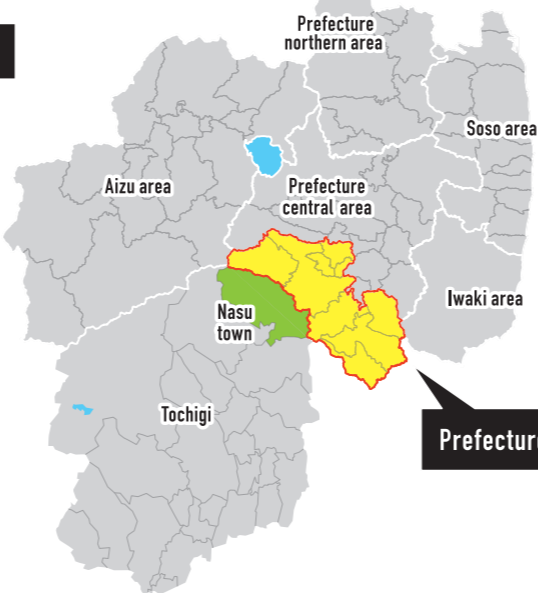

# HISTORY

There are numerous historical sites and buildings from ancient times, the Middle Ages and early modern times. Experience what has been passed down in the Shirakawa area and what will continue into the future.

This shrine was built in 1054 and is dedicated to the Ama Terasu Omikami (God). It is said that during the mid-Heian period, Minamoto no Yoshiie admired the beautiful scenery of this area, stored his bow and arrows in a rock cave, held a festival to report his victory, and prayed for long life in military fortune, hence the origins of the name.

This is the ruins of a castle built in 1625 by Nagashige Niwa, the second lord of the Tanagura domain. Over the 240 years until the castle fell during the Boshin War, there were 8 families and 16 generations of castle owners. In the spring, pale pink cherry blossoms bloom along the moat of the castle ruins, and in autumn, the leaves of the trees surrounding the moat turn red and reflect on the water.

The main shrine, Atago Shrine, is located in Kyoto and is dedicated to the god of firefighting. After the war, there were many large fires, so a large festival was held in 1952 to revive the festival, and the large festival is still held once every three years. It is commonly called the Water Festival.

The building has a gate-like structure that connects two buildings with a roof, and the road between the two buildings is the old National Route 289 (Kashi Kaido).
